- Two letters of recommendation
- Certification from supervisor that Eligibility Criteria are met (may be submitted in any format)

SELECTION PROCESS

The selection of applications will be based on objective business-related criteria such as:

- Documented performance/success factors, e.g. performance plans.
- Contributions to the department in the field of natural and/or cultural resource conservation or in their profession.
- Is the educational goal related to a Texas Parks and Wildlife Department career field?
- Will the educational goal develop staff resources to fill critical shortage positions (positions that do not generate a diverse applicant pool despite recruitment efforts)?
- Will the educational opportunity promote access to non-traditional jobs?
- Other objective business-related criteria determined by the selection team.

SCHOLARSHIP PAYMENT

Scholarship payment will be made upon successful completion of the semester and evidence of final grade has been submitted (grade report, receipts for tuition, books, supplies and any other school-related expenses). Payment will be dependent on recipient maintaining overall GPA of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
